

Understanding Jesus: A Deprogramming Guide

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It's not necessary for you to have seen "Hellraiser" nor be familiar with the work of Clive Barker, but, it may help you understand some of the references and reasons for this guide. In fact, without Clive Barker and "Hellraiser", I may never have thought "what if the Holy Bible was the puzzle box and depending on interpretation and understanding could open the gates of heaven or hell?" Clive Barker's "The Great and Secret Show" is also helpful or so I've found.

JESUS AS THE SACRIFICIAL LAMB:

In fulfilling Genesis and concluding the death of Abel (second born, though most favored) with the death of the favored first born of Mary, namely Jesus, it resolves the arguable issue with Cain and God. Abel killed and sacrificed the lamb for and/or of God and Cain killed Abel, then lived in exile, with the story of Jesus saying God forgives Cain for killing Abel for killing the lamb of God or Cain's reprisal as Jesus reinforcing reincarnation and knowing Jesus can be more Jesus or more Cain depending on environmental factors and social influences. Given Jesus' firm commitment to God, likely coming back pissed off when reincarnating especially when slaughtered for killing chomos and being angry the temple was more like a house of ill-repute which is more offensive than anyone can stand. Did Abel rape a child in the name of God? Is that part of the subtext? Does God exile Cain as symbolic of death with the promise of reincarnation which we see with Jesus who was also conceived out of wedlock? Think about how Cain is the firstborn of Adam and Eve and they had sex out of wedlock which is why they were kicked out of the garden. Cain was born of their "lust" supposedly, but, conceived in the Garden of Eden because it happened before they were kicked out. So, did Mary get pregnant in or near the Garden of Eden? Regardless, it should resolve the issue and also lends itself to some humor depending on your perspective and interpretation.

JESUS AS SAVIOR AND BEARER OF ALL BURDENS:

That is so fucked up and only narcissistic moronic whores would say, "Gee, you know, there's this historical figure that says if I believe he died so I could sin all I want with no consequences then I get to do whatever vicious, dishonest, evil shit I want and I'm forgiven." And, it is extra evil to have that be the message to children who are led by hypocrites whom Jesus despised almost as much as the evil child rapist swine he forced off a cliff to their death with a stone weighing them down like a good Mafioso. But, getting angry that the temple was a modernization of Sodom and Gomorrah, he raids it tossing tables and that's on top of killing the evil child rapist swine. This has led to some of the most vicious among us saying things like "Cry with me. Release your pain. Give me money if you feel better as I soothsay. I tell you now, repeat after me and you will be saved "I accept Jesus Christ as my personal lord and savior", say it and all will be forgiven." Whomsoever is saying that shit doesn't understand Jesus and is a false prophet. Jesus believes in accountability and thinks everyone should get a clean slate between incarnations and not carry any karmic baggage from life to life. So, clearly if he stormed the house of ill-repute acting like a temple and killed a bunch of demonic child raping swine while arguably leading a slave revolt, any arguable karmic debt to the demonic child raping swine is cleared unless they reincarnate and he realizes that when reincarnated and it is very "Terminator 2: Judgment Day". I believe Jesus would love that and I feel like

the US Constitution is a fulfillment of Jesus' legacy from the best possible perspective. I believe Jesus might love the Declaration of Independence more than the US Constitution before amended to abolish slavery except as a punishment for crimes such as human trafficking and child rape. So, as an example, the whole Truth about Jesus is that he had a temper, was tempted to Wrath on more than one occasion which he acted upon in an unlawful manner at the time, and instead of exile was crucified to death (though later reincarnated) for those unlawful acts at the time. See, if I was Jesus' defense attorney at his trial, I would say "Those forced off the cliff to their death raped children and the entire action was in defense of the children. In defense of others is recognized at law." Then, the other side would say "Was this based on reports or did you witness all the rapes of children? How does that work?
