

A Sermon on Dehumanizing Orphans and Children

Sermon by Rev. Minister Angela Smith of COPE for September 22nd, 2024 (and beyond)

Ignorance and superstition were historically, and to some extent still are, quite rampant. Various health challenges were not yet identified as being other than a trick, curse, or some form of divine retribution brought on the family by evil and/or punitive supernatural forces or beings. Modern storytelling has continued the tradition with films such as "The Bad Orphan" (2024), "Orphan" (2009), "Orphan: First Kill" (2022), and historically in the myth of Loki who is the adopted son of Odin in some Norse Myths but others have Thor as the father and Loki as Odin's adoptive brother. There's also Beowulf with Grendel who in the film version with Anthony Hopkins as the patriarch is actually his bastard offspring with a water-nymph of some sort played by Angelina Jolie. But, does that make Grendel an orphan if only abandoned by his father and still raised by his mother? Do you have to be abandoned by both parents to be considered an orphan? Myths around orphans and other children have labeled them monsters, changelings, and foundlings.

In Judaism historically and reportedly ""Those foundlings which were suspected of having been born through illegitimate connections were placed outside of the fold, and they might not intermarry with Israelites, nor with other foundlings or illegitimates. The only persons whom they were permitted to marry were proselytes and liberated slaves; and the offspring of such marriages were in the same status as the foundlings themselves (Kid. 74a; Maimonides, l.c. 33; Eben ha-'Ezer, 4, 36)." One malady not identified above is Postpartum Depression, which is likely where evil mothers or stepmothers get their mythology to some extent.

The issue here is that there is some truth on which to base some of the myths, though it is similar to saying all humans are murderers because some commit murder. And, when

arguably attacking or demonizing an already vulnerable demographic with attachment and/or abandonment issues or depicting such demographics as monsters where impressionable ones may internalize and self-identify based on the mythology or lash out defensively reinforcing the mythic stereotype, are we as a society perpetuating a self-fulfilling prophecy?

There is horror to be had on all sides. And, stepparents and foster/adoptive parents are not immune in fairytales nor the thriller/suspense/horror genre(s). “Domestic Disturbance” released in 2001 is just one example.

“Our recent study of mothers found not guilty by reason of insanity in two U.S. states found that the perpetrators were often depressed and frequently experienced auditory hallucinations, some of a command type. Over one third of the homicides occurred during pregnancy or the postpartum year. Almost all the mothers had altruistic or acutely psychotic motives (22). A small New Zealand study that interviewed the mothers after their filicides found that psychotic mothers who had committed filicide often killed suddenly without much planning, whereas depressed mothers had contemplated killing their children for days to weeks prior to their crimes (49).” Source: <https://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pmc/articles/PMC2174580/>

The microscope wasn't invented until the 1590s, but the first one that worked properly wasn't invented until 1830.
