It's possible even more pigeons were killed than were recorded. It's as if parasites wiped out the whole village. But, nicotine is no longer used as a common pesticide in agriculture to protect food crops and the new pesticides that are tobacco-free kill 10% of birds exposed to it annually, the other 90% exposed do not die immediately or as a result of exposure.
