A Sermon on "The Tao of Pooh" a Book by Benjamin Hoff Sermon by Rev. Minister Angela Smith of COPE for April 9th, 2023 (and beyond)

First, I wish everyone a happy Easter no matter how, if, or when you celebrate! I recently read "The Tao of Pooh" by Benjamin Hoff. DIALOGUE

Yes, being spoiled rotten by an affluent provider is very easy, but they can put an end to that at any time which is why dependents feel vulnerable in light of their failure to contribute anything of value beyond their presence such as it may be and resort to vicious and deceptive conduct to secure their position and subjugate their provider rather than pursue independence by providing for themselves. Christopher Robin laments that when he goes to school, he will not be allowed to do Nothing any more." Source:

https://bookriot.com/avoid-that-last-chapter-in-the-house-at-pooh-corner/ And, from a Judeo-Christian perspective, the meaning of "The House on Pooh Corner" is best summarized with 1 Corinthians 13:11 (KJV) "When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things." And, though Christopher Robin has been 6-years old since 1928, we know his story didn't end there because there is a clear suggestion that he at least went on to school even if we don't get to know the rest or are welcome to imagine it ourselves. In 1928 the population was far less dense in the USA and most people didn't have televisions because they didn't even exist until September, 1927. So, children had to find other ways to entertain themselves and at least pretend to have a social life if separated from other children for miles with very few, if any, play dates until they finally go to school. But, school mandates are decided by the individual states in the US with Massachusetts being first to so mandate in 1852 and Alaska the last in 1929. Although, AA Milne lived in England his whole life and school was mandated for those age 5-13 years old as of 1893. This suggests Christopher Robin may have had some developmental delay unless the story takes place during school breaks like Summer vacation.
